Session 1 – 5:00 pm Why Websphere? SPEAKER: Doug Fulmer

Abstract: This is your foundation session/course to understand the goals and values of the WebSphere products. We will discuss the Java 2 Enterprise Edition (J2EE) platform which is enabled with the WebSphere products. Learn about Model, View, Controller (MVC), your choices of platforms and software providers.

Bio: Doug Fulmer joined IBM in 1974 in Little Rock, Arkansas. He spent 14 years in the branch office there as a midrange Systems Engineer working on S/3, S/32, S/34, S/36 S/38 and AS/400. In 1988 he joined the Kansas City Area Systems Center as an AS/400 specialist, working primarily in the areas of communications and PC connectivity. He worked for the Minneapolis and Dallas Area Systems Centers in a similar capacity before joining the AS/400 Competency Center in Dallas in 1991 where he specialized in Client Server application development. In 1993 he joined the AS/400 brand team as Segment Manager for DB2/400. In 1996 he became part of the group that brought the IBM Network Station to market, then returned to the AS/400 Division as the world-wide Segment Manager for Application Development Tools and Middleware in June of 1998.
