**ABSTRACT:** It’s a case study that involves Americana Ships, a shipping company in the USA that is owned by CP Ships and the business advantages behind their Web-to-host solution implementation. Agents around the world are using it to print large manifests and invoices with embedded overlays securely over the Internet. They are using it to provide Agents with secure remote access over the Internet to their AS/400 applications. And recently using XML and the Web-to-host solution to Web enable their AS/400 Vessel Scheduling System which now provides realtime information about the vessel schedules. The presentation will provide a technical overview of the software used to deploy such a solution and the business reasons behind it.
